Parade Details

The parade will start at **8:30 a.m.** sharp on the Fourth of July. The parade begins at Indiana and Rock Creek Parkway and winds down Rock Creek Parkway to Community Park. The parade **vehicles** will go south on Rock Creek Parkway to Coalton and proceed west to the Community Park entrance. All **pedestrian** parade traffic will filter out of the parade route and be directed west on the path behind Safeway shopping center to the pancake breakfast.

Parade line-up for large groups, vehicles and floats, will take place on Indiana Street from Eldorado Drive to Rock Creek Parkway. This portion of Indiana will be blocked off for all general traffic beginning at 7:00 a.m. (***)There will be no parking in the pool or school lots after 7:00 a.m. and no one will be able to leave those lots until the parade has cleared those areas and the barricades are removed.) It is best to come north from Coalton Road to align your vehicle or float in the proper direction for the parade.

Large group vehicle and float line-up starts at 7:00 a.m. and **all entrants MUST be in position by 8:00 a.m.** General population participants will begin line-up at 8:00 a.m. and it is imperative that all vehicles are in place before then. You will be contacted approximately one week prior to the parade with an assigned position for line-up. Judging of the floats starts when the parade starts at 8:30 a.m. with awards being announced at the pancake breakfast following the parade.
